

District University Coordinator (DUC) Telegraph #1

This is the first DUC Telegraph for 2018; it is my way to pass along information to you. I normally send DUC Telegraphs each month but whenever there is information to share; I'll send another DUC Telegraph.

First, thanks for continuing your role as Trainers for our members. I know being a Trainer takes time to prepare, takes travel time, and can be a hit on your finances. I want to tell you all I really appreciate your dedication to the members. We have had some Trainers decide to step away from training; they want & need a break. I totally understand their position to recharge themselves as members and to enjoy their time away from the classroom. As a result of that, our Trainer numbers within Virginia has reduced to 18 active Trainer; down from 24.

What does this mean... it means we may have to travel more. As a result of more travel, I have been authorized by the District Director to establish a program to assist in

your finances when traveling to present training on behalf of the Virginia District. I sent the form last year in Trainer Telegraph #14. This form is only to be used within the Virginia District. Receipts are required; if receipts are not submitted, you will not receive that percentage for your expenses. I have been given approval from the District Director to start this program.

Starting today, if you are contacted by a Chapter Director (CD) to perform training, please let me know. There are 2 reasons for this; first reason is I maintain a spreadsheet of who presents training and where it was presented. The second reason is I have to verify you are current in your certification, this includes your Levels. I will also attach a listing of all Training available; this listing also identified what Level the Trainer must be in order to present training. This listing can also be found on the GWRRA University website.

The Officer Certification Program (OCP) is not authorized to be presented; this is due to the restructuring of GWRRA. However, until the OCP comes back online (being revised now), there are four modules GWRRA recommends new officers and members attend. Those modules are Coaching for Leaders, Checks & Balances, On the Level, and the Communications module of the Horizons Program. Please always check the GWRRA University website to ensure you are presenting the latest module or seminar. The GWRRA University website also has the latest forms needed for administrative purposes.

Please remember, any training must be accompanied by submitting a U-3 to certify.renew@gmail.com and cc myself so I have a copy for my records.

Based on the changes to GWRRA, the District is required to have 4 Quarterly training events; one of these events will be Rally in the Valley. I encourage each of you to look for training venues; this will help us provide training for Chapters around the District. We have some Trainers looking at training venues in Suffolk, Chesterfield, and Danville, but we need more places to present training. The challenges we face with facilities are size, location, and cost. If you know of a facility that may be suitable for training, please let me know. We will look into the facility to see if we can come to an agreement.

The 4 Training Events will involve the District Educator, the District University Coordinator (DUC-that's me) and the District Ride Coordinator (appointment TBD). These events will require Trainers to present various Modules and

Seminars to our members and may also have members from outside the District from attending. Each time the District hosts a Training Event, a flyer is required and must be approved by GWRRA National. This flier will then be distributed and may result in out of District members attending. I challenge you to also invite riders not in GWRRA; this may result in recruitment.

The District OPS meeting is in Charlottesville on 20 January. I will attend and follow-up with a DUC Telegraph to keep you all informed with what was covered.

If you don't know, you can verify your Rider Education and Training information by logging into the National website.
