### When Can We Gather Again?

In response to the question as to when we can start Gathering again, I remind you that GWRRA suggested we follow the guidelines from the CDC and the State government. The Association did not suggest guidelines of their own.

Below is a brief description of the guidelines established by Virginia. We further suggest that you check with your individual meeting places (restaurants, churches, etc.) to see if they



are still willing to accommodate you. Some of them have cut back operating hours, some are still not willing to host groups of any size. An alternative may be to check out parks in your area and use a pavilion for meeting.

Governor Northam has indicated that Virginia moves to Phase 2 today, Friday, June 5, except for Richmond and No-Va that will remain at Phase 1. The summarized list of what is allowed in Phase 2 is:

- Reopening indoor seating at restaurants at 50% capacity
- Reopening indoor gyms at 30% capacity
- Reopening of entertainment venues such as zoos, museums, and botanical gardens
- Reopening swimming pools with restrictions
- Resuming recreational sports with restrictions
- Increases limits on social gatherings from 10 to 50 people
- Face masks will still be required in indoor spaces (except when eating) and teleworking is still recommended.

#### GWRRA RIDER EDUCATION PROGRAM EXTENDS THE LEVELS PROGRAM GRACE PERIOD

Members participating in the Rider Education Levels Program who have expired or will expire on or after **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020** are granted a grace period that has been extended until **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020** allowing time for the Member to take part in one or more of the following courses or classes to bring their level up to date:

- GWRRA (or RE Program approved alternative) on-bike course
- The University's Co-Rider seminar
- GWRRA MEDIC FIRST AID® (or MFA Program approved alternative) class.

#### The grace period will not be decreased and may be extended if deemed necessary.

**GWRRA Rider Course Instructors** who may be affected during this or any grace period please contact Chuck Geggie, REP Assistant-Rider Course Program directly.

**MFA Instructors** should contact the MFA Director Laurel Kuehl directly with any questions or concerns about how this may impact them.

**District Educators** should continue to accept and process database updates. N.9 Master applications should be submitted to the Director, Rider Education Program using one of the following methods:

• Scan and forward the N.9 Application and Letter of Recommendation to the Director, Rider Education Program, <u>director-re@gwrra.org</u> for review and approval by return email.

Submission of the approved Application and check to the Home Office will be the responsibility of the District Educator.

Submission of the approved Application and check to the Home Office will be the responsibility of the Director, Rider Education Program.

Many have asked, others are waiting, and some have already decided. Yes, the question is "What is happening with Wings Over the Smokies?"



**Wings Over the Smokies 2021 is a go! But not so for WOtS 2020.** We want you all to know how hard of a decision this was to come to, but we really felt the safety and health of our members to be our first obligation. The beautiful hills and mountains still call us to enjoy their thrills and their beauty; the Smoky Mountains will hold over all their grandeur for us.

We are extremely excited to say that in place of Wings Over the Smokies 2020, we are working to organize the first "Wings Over Carolina".

- "Wings Over Carolina" will be 3 separate regional rides spread across our state with specific routes and gathering points and will be in the fall, sometimes between the middle of September and the middle of October.
- "Wings Over Carolina" will be an open-air focused event; meeting, riding, picnicking, and playing, all outside.
- "Wings Over Carolina" will maintain safe social distancing and allow for masking as individuals may deem appropriate.
- "Wings Over Carolina" will allow us to visit personally with friends.
- "Wings Over Carolina" will not require hotels.
- "Wings Over Carolina" will be exciting!
- "Wings Over Carolina" will be fun!
- "Wings Over Carolina" will welcome 2 wheels, 3 wheels or 4 wheels.

We will do our best to schedule the "Wings Over Carolina" ride for the western region (mountains) during the previously scheduled dates for WOtS (September 24th, 25th or 26th). We hope this will facilitate people that had plans to attend WOtS to come and join us for the western "Wings Over Carolina" ride.

Of course we understand if you prefer to stay home, no one knows what the next few months will hold, but on the assumption that the virus is beginning to come under control in the US, we would like to continue to ride together, even while we can't gather in large groups. We believe this is the absolute best way to balance the health and safety of all GWRRA members with our collective desire to gather, ride, and have fun.
